

Small Box



Difficulty – Easy

Materials

- Oatmeal colored wrapping paper
- Exotic flower scrapbooking paper
- 1-1/2-inch-wide sheer metallic ribbon (a color that coordinates with the scrapbooking paper)
- 1 square ceramic bead (strings of ceramic beads sometimes include small beads)
- 4 small round black beads
- **Scotch® Gift Wrap Cutter** (for cutting wrapping paper)
- **Scotch® Double Sided Tape or Scotch® Pop-Up Tape** (for wrapping gift)
- **Scotch® Precision Scissors** (for cutting scrapbooking paper and ribbon)
- **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick** (for attaching scrapbooking paper)
- **Scotch® Clear Glue with 2-Way Applicator** (for gluing ribbon)
- **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** (for gluing beads)

Instructions

1. Wrap a box in oatmeal colored wrapping paper using either **Scotch® Double Sided Tape** or **Scotch® Pop-Up Tape**.
2. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors** cut a piece of the exotic flower scrapbooking paper the entire length and width of the top of the box.
3. Using the **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick**, apply glue to the wrong side of the scrapbooking paper, especially around the edges. Attach it to the top of the box, lining up the edges of the paper with the edges of the box.



4. Cut a piece of the sheer ribbon long enough to wrap around the width of the box plus 1 inch.
5. Wrap the ribbon around the box overlapping and gluing the ends on the bottom of the box with the precision tip of **Scotch® Clear Glue**.



6. Apply a small amount of **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** to the back of each of the beads and attach them to the bag in the configuration shown below.



Gift Bag

Sheer ribbon is attached to the front handle instead of using tissue paper to give the bag a more exotic look.



Difficulty – Easy

Materials

- Oatmeal colored gift bag with stiff handles (plain gift bags are inexpensive and easy to find at your local craft or party store)
- Exotic flower scrapbooking paper (double-sided with a solid coordinating color on the other side)
- 1-1/2-inch-wide sheer metallic ribbon (a color that coordinates with the scrapbooking paper)
- 3 square ceramic bead (strings of ceramic beads sometimes include small beads)
- 4 small round black beads
- **Scotch® Precision Scissors** (for cutting scrapbooking paper and ribbon)
- **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick** (for attaching scrapbooking paper)
- **Scotch® Clear Glue with 2-Way Applicator** (for gluing ribbon)
- **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** (for gluing beads)

Instructions

1. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors** cut a piece of the exotic flower scrapbooking paper the entire width and 2-1/2 inches smaller than the length of the front of the bag.
2. Using the **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick**, apply glue to the wrong side of the flower paper, especially around the edges. Attach it to the front of the bag lining up the bottom edge of the paper with the bottom edge of the bag.
3. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors** cut a piece of the back, solid colored side of the scrapbooking paper, 2-1/2 inches long and the entire width of the front of the bag.
4. Using the **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick**, apply glue to the flower side of the scrapbooking paper, especially around the edges. Attach it to the front of the bag lining up the top edge of the paper with the top edge of the bag.



3. Cut a piece of the metallic sheer ribbon the entire width of the front of the gift bag.
4. Using the precision tip of **Scotch® Clear Glue**, attach the pink ribbon to the front of the gift bag, centered over the edges of the scrapbooking paper. Small amounts of glue can be added to the cut edges of each side of the ribbon to prevent fraying.



5. Apply a small amount of **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** to the back of each of the beads and attach to the bag in the configuration shown below.



5. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors** cut a piece of the sheer metallic ribbon 1 inch wider than the width of the handles.
6. Apply a small amount of **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** to the edge of one side of the ribbon and wrap it around one side of the front handle, about 1/2 inch from the top of the gift bag. Hold it until it is secure. Repeat on the other side of the handle.
7. Wrap your gift in recycled paper or tissue and place in the bag to complete this unique gift presentation.



Rectangular Box

This design can be adapted to almost any size or shape box.



Difficulty – Easy

Materials

- Oatmeal colored wrapping paper
- Exotic flower scrapbooking paper (double-sided with a solid coordinating color on the other side)
- 1-1/2-inch-wide sheer metallic ribbon (a color that coordinates with the scrapbooking paper)
- 2 square ceramic bead (strings of ceramic beads sometimes include small beads)
- 3 small round black beads
- **Scotch® Gift Wrap Cutter** (for cutting wrapping paper)
- **Scotch® Double Sided Tape or Scotch® Pop-Up Tape** (for wrapping gift)
- **Scotch® Precision Scissors** (for cutting scrapbooking paper and ribbon)
- **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick** (for attaching scrapbooking paper)
- **Scotch® Clear Glue with 2-Way Applicator** (for gluing ribbon)
- **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** (for gluing beads)

Instructions

1. Wrap a box in oatmeal colored wrapping paper using either **Scotch® Double Sided Tape** or **Scotch® Pop-Up Tape**.
2. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors** cut a piece of the exotic flower scrapbooking paper 1-1/2 inch smaller than the width and the full length the top of the box.
3. Using the **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick**, apply glue to the wrong side of the craft paper especially around the edges. Attach the craft paper to the box, lining up the edge of the paper with the right edge of the box.

4. Using **Scotch® Precision Scissors** cut a piece of the back, solid colored side of the scrapbooking paper, 1-1/2 inch wide and the full length of the top of the box.
5. Using the **Scotch® Clear Glue Stick**, apply glue to the flower side of the scrapbooking paper, especially around the edges. Attach it to the top of the box lining up the left edge of the paper with the left edge of the box.



7. Cut a piece of the sheer ribbon long enough to wrap around the length of the box plus 1 inch.
8. Wrap the ribbon around the box centered over the edges of the scrapbooking paper. Overlap and glue the ends on the bottom of the box with the precision tip of **Scotch® Clear Glue**.



5. Apply a small amount of **Scotch® Quick-Dry Adhesive** to the back of each of the beads and attach to the bag in the configuration shown below.
